
As you are aware that the State Government has decided to set up IT enabled village Secretariats in the State. Recently, a meeting held with Principal Secretary IT department. Wherein it was decided that the citizen service centre will also be located in the Village Secretariats so that the citizens are provided all kinds of services in the same premises. Therefore, you are requested to co-locate the citizen service centres in the village Secretariats/Panchayat Ghars/Rajiv Sewa Kendra. In this context you may also ensure that the NOFN also terminates in these buildings, so that the IT enabled services can be fully leveraged for development of villages.

It is also being proposed that the village level entrepreneur who runs a citizen service should be able to perform the IT related tasks of the panchayat offices for which he can be suitably compensated. This model has been adopted by State of Maharashtra successfully. This will also provide a good synergy between citizen services and those being provided by the panchayat. The citizen service centre becoming a part of panchayat office gives rise to possibilities like the village level entrepreneur also becoming a business correspondent for the banks .

Therefore, while making selections for the entrepreneurs for the citizen service centres, this factor may also be kept in mind so that the person is capable of performing above said responsibilities. The detailed instructions in this regarding would be sent by IT department shortly.
