

ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

I, Nikhil Gajraj, IAS, District Magistrate, Hisar am of the opinion that on the occasion of Diwali Festival, the selling/storage and user of fire crackers and explosive materials in congested place, Street, Market on Highway, Public thoroughfare or Public Place may cause danger to human life, health and safety of property. It is, therefore necessary to issue such directions/order to avoid any mishappening/annoyance or injury and safety of human life and property.

Thus, exercising the power vested in me under Section 144 Cr.P.C. and under the provisions of the Explosives Act, 1884 and Rules thereunder 2008, it is expedient to issue directions to restrain the dealers, shop keepers and public at large to store, sell and use fire crackers/explosive material etc. in public interest in District Hisar in the following manner :-

1. That no person shall sell/store fire crackers/explosive materials without obtaining licence under the Indian Explosive Act, 1884 and rules there under.
2. No person shall sell and store fire works and explosive materials without licence.
3. No person shall store more than the quantity as prescribed under the law.
4. No person shall sell Rocket, fast moving Surri and dangerous types of Bombs which have been restricted by law or by any order of the Courts.

Keeping in view, directions issued by the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court CWP No. 23548 of 2017, Fire crackers shall be bursted only between 06.30 PM to 09.30 PM on the day of Diwali i.e. 19.10.2017. The persons found violating these orders shall be punishable under section 188 IPC and contempt of court proceedings shall also be instituted on the violation.

It is not possible to serve this notice to the public at large individually, and due to the circumstances of urgency this order is passed Ex-Parte and is addressed to general public at large. These orders shall come into force with immediate effect and expire on 22 October, 2017.
